## Zebra Danio

Zebra Danios (scientific name, *Danio rerio*) are freshwater fish belonging to the family *Cyprinidae*. They are easily one of the most popular freshwater aquarium fish due to their hardiness and easy care. Best kept in groups of 6 or more, Zebras make an active addition to community aquariums, bringing movement and life to any aquascape.

The body of Zebra Danios is a shimmering metallic silver/gold accented with bright, blue zebra stripes with a hint of purple. Female Zebra Danios have more subdued coloration than males. They co-exist peacefully with other species of Danios as well as with other peaceful fish of similar size, making them a safe bet for the beginner.
