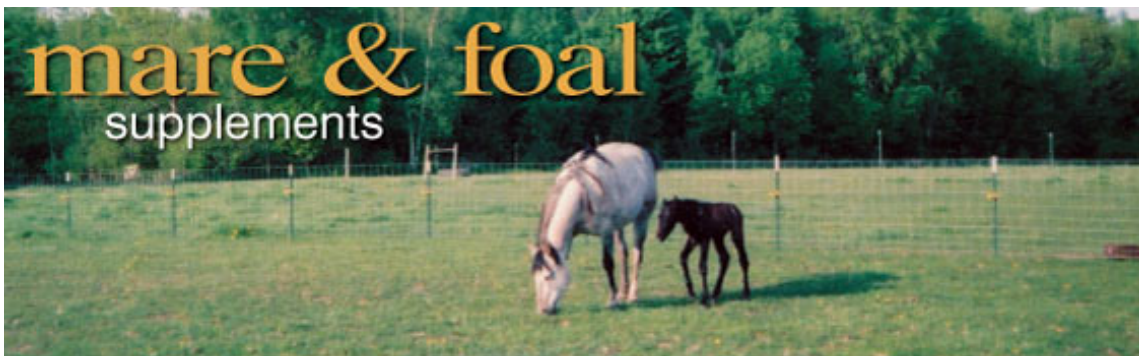


Mare & Foal Supplements: Compare

Both breeding mares and their foals need special supplementation to ensure their good health. Folic Acid is needed for mare and foal health as well as antioxidants, calcium, and iron. The following is a chart listing the products we carry and the amount of specific ingredients they have.
