

Ms. Ferret's Easy Chicken Soup Recipe

Ingredients:

- 4 lbs of chicken, boiled
- 2-1/2 cups of [kibble](#), soaked in the water used to boil the chicken
- 2 scoops of [Nupro](#)

Directions:

1. Boil the chicken for approximately 20 - 25 minutes, depending on the size and thickness of the pieces.
2. Remove from pot, break into small pieces (if you have a smaller blender).
3. Pour 1/4 of the water over the kibble to soak.
4. Blend chicken with half of the water used to boil it. Set aside in a bowl.
5. Puree the kibble with the rest of the chicken water and Nupro.
6. Combine pureed kibble and chicken in a bowl and stir together.
7. Pour into containers and put the needed amount in the fridge and the rest in the freezer.
